WASHINGTON – Four new members have been appointed to the Department of Veterans Affairs' (VA) Advisory Committee on Women Veterans, an expert panel that advises the Secretary on issues and programs affecting women veterans. Of the approximately 22 million living veterans, about 2 million are women veterans. They comprise 9.2 percent of the total veteran population. VA estimates that by 2040, women veterans will comprise approximately 16 percent of the total veteran population.

- Ms. Octavia Harris, El Cajon, California, a retired Command Master Chief, U.S. Navy; currently serves as a program manager of the Comprehensive Advanced Restorative Effort at the San Diego Naval Medical Center;
